2021 SCHOOL CHARGES AND VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS

The Ardross Primary School Board has endorsed the following schedule of School Charges and Voluntary Contributions for 2021. The schedule is broken into four sections and will allow you to calculate all possible costs that you might incur throughout the next school year.

VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS

a) Voluntary School Contribution to support Curriculum Areas:

The School Board has again reviewed our school Voluntary Contributions and the amount parents and carers are being asked to pay for 2021 has been maintained at the \$60 maximum set in the School Education Regulations 2000.

Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure in curriculum focus areas. While these contributions are voluntary, the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes its contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth Governments.

b) Voluntary P&C Contribution:

Other voluntary approved funds at Ardross Primary School include P&C Contributions of \$50 per family. This voluntary contribution is administered by the P&C Committee and used to fund and support school initiatives and focus areas that meet the needs of our children.

c) Voluntary Sustainability Initiatives Contribution:

Ardross Primary School is proudly committed to sustainability. In 2021, funds raised from this voluntary contribution will go towards contracting waste services to manage co-mingled recycling and the gradual changeover of our expensive and energy hungry fluorescent lights to cheaper, low power consumption LED lighting.

UP FRONT CHARGE FOR INCURSIONS AND EXCURSIONS

2021 Returning Families

The option to pay up front charges is not included in the 2021 book lists due to the impact of COVID-19 and the amount of credit funds still held in many student accounts.

We would ask that you please contact the office to check your child/ren's credit balance and to arrange payment as necessary.

Please note Voluntary Contributions are not included in the up front charges option and can be paid via the book list or at any time in the office.

2021 New Families

An up front payment at the start of each year is requested to cover the cost of expenses that take place over the course of the year. Incursion and Excursion costs will be deducted from this amount as they occur (with parent permission) and any balance in this account at the end of the school year will roll over into the following year. Any unallocated credit balance can be transferred to a sibling, donated to the school, or refunded via EFT when the student leaves the school.

There is an option to pay half the annual amount per semester.

The up front charge payment is more efficient for parents, teachers and school accounting processes, as costs throughout the year will be debited against your child's unallocated credit balance. You can obtain your child's unallocated credit balance at any time during the course of the year by calling our office on **9364 2771**.

Please note Voluntary Contributions are not included in the up front charges option and can be paid via the book list or at any time in the office.
