

Ardross Primary School Dress Code

Rationale

All public schools are required to have a dress code and students are required to comply with the code unless they have been granted an exemption.

At Ardross Primary School, our staff and School Board have established a Dress Code for all students attending the school.

At Ardross PS...

The wearing of the school uniform at all times is encouraged.

Modification of the school uniform to meet the religious or medical needs of individual students can be granted by the Principal.

The P&C operates a school uniform shop. In addition, order forms will be available through the front office and online through the school website.

Clothing of the same style and colour may be purchased from alternate sources.

Acceptance of enrolment at Ardross PS assumes that parents will support the school's dress code.

Benefits of a Dress Code

A Dress Code...

- Promotes a positive image of the school.
- Creates a sense of community and belonging among students.
- Promotes safety of students through easier identification.
- Keeps costs of clothing within reasonable limits for parents.
- Assists students to learn the importance of appropriate presentation.

Student Dress Code Requirements

School Polo Shirt - Yellow with School Logo

Bottle Green Shorts (Gabardine/Cargo)

Shorts are to no longer than knee length

Green & White Check School Dress Bottle Green Sports Skirt or Skort

Bottle Green Zip Jacket or Crew Neck Jumper Bottle Green Track Pants (Stretch Knit) or (Stretch Knit) Cargo Pants

Bottle Green Rain Jacket (Nylon, Fleece-lined)

It is preferred that winter tops include the school logo.

Bottle Green or Black Leggings Legging may only be worn under a school dress, or bottle green skirt, skort or shorts (not as a solo item)

Denim, beanies, and board shorts **ARE NOT** considered part of our dress code. Shirts and shorts with slogans, messages, picture designs or advertising **ARE NOT** acceptable.

Transition to Updated School Logo

In 2020, Ardross PS introduced an updated school logo. Families have been provided time to transition school uniforms from those featuring the previous logo to those featuring the current logo.

From 2024, all school polo shirts should feature the current school logo.

From 2025, all uniform items featuring a school logo, should feature the current school logo.

Additional

Footwear	Sneakers, sandals, or enclosed shoes are required. Thongs or slip-on shoes ARE NOT appropriate.
	It is recommended that all footwear be suitable for physical activity.
Hats	A bottle green broad-brimmed (8-10cm) hat is to be worn outside all year round. All other hats ARE NOT considered acceptable.
Sports	Students should have a Faction polo shirt (Faction colour with white stripe containing the faction name).
	Faction shirts are to be worn ONLY on Physical Education or school sports days. Students are required to wear sneakers during all Phys Ed lessons.
	The Phys Ed teacher will ensure that interschool sports uniforms are available for selected students (if applicable).
Jewellery	Only studs or sleepers earrings, watches, and medical bracelets may be worn. No other jewellery is considered appropriate.
	When participating in physical activity, students may be required to remove items of jewellery.
	Smart watches or other wearable devices with internet connectivity ARE NOT permitted.
Hair & Make-Up	Shoulder-length hair should be tied back at all times. Fringes must be out of the eyes (either cut short or clipped back).
	Permanent unnatural colour hair dye is NOT allowed. The use of temporary hair dye is acceptable only during sports carnivals and themed dress-up days.
	Cosmetics and nail polish ARE NOT permitted.
Graduation	The Graduation (Leavers') shirt is only to be worn by students in Year 6, and is considered to be
Shirt	part of the school uniform. Graduation shirts are to feature the school colours, have the school
	crest on the front, and the graduating students' names and year on the back.
	All Year 6 students should acquire a graduation shirt as they may be required to wear this on
	special occasions.
River	The River Rangers shirt is to be blue and include the school's name and appropriate insignia.
Rangers	The school will provide each selected student with a River Rangers shirt.
	The River Rangers shirt is to be worn while participating in official River Rangers Activities.

Procedures for Non-Compliance with the Dress Code

At Ardross Primary School, breaches of the dress code (student) will result in:

- Parents being notified that their child is inappropriately dressed.
- Assistance or support to obtain suitable clothing (if necessary).
- Counselling of the students on the expectations and benefits of the school uniform.
- Students not following the dress code will be unable to attend excursions, or represent the school at interschool events, community events or official school functions.
